

Bible study for the week starting May 11, 2025

SHARE

Has God used a difficulty to bring you to repentance? Have you walked through difficulty and it has lead you to rejection? When have you most seen the presence of God? Was it when you were in darkness or when it was "bright" outside?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

Read Revelation 9:13-19?

- a. What happened at the horns of the altar?
- b. How is judgment...now AND not yet? Ongoing and not completed?
- c. We are still awaiting the "Day of the Lord." Look at these references to the Day and see how it is described. (1 Peter 3, Amos 5, Joel 2, Isaiah 13, Zephaniah 1)

Read Revelation 9:20-21

a. What were the things that remained unchanged? Head, heart, hands. What does repentance look like you?

Whole of the Christian life is one of repentance. How is this true for you?

b. Why is repentance more than a "one time" event?

Read Matthew 23:1-39?


c. What is Jesus calling out? What is his desire for the people that are tasked with pointing to God? Why does Jesus give the pharisees 7 woes?

Read Psalm 139:1-16

- a. What is the most comforting line in this Psalm?
- b. "Even the darkness is as light to you." How does this promise live in your soul?

PRAY

Pray for the presence of our God in the darkness. Pray for a heart that is soft and turns toward the Lord in the midst of trouble...Pray that our world would know the power and presence of Jesus in the midst of tribulation.



EVEN THE DARKNESS

Revelation 9:13-21

"Let me take REFUGE under the shelter of your wings" (Ps. 61:4).
