2. Read also [Zechariah 14:4-10](#). There is a concept that the Messiah would stand on the Mount of Olives and judge the nations. How do we (or don't we) see this fulfilled by Jesus on Palm Sunday (or elsewhere)?
3. Read [Philippians 2:5-11](#). We see Jesus exalted on Palm Sunday, but also exalted in His greatest moments of humiliation. How would you describe this?
4. What do you treasure most, or what resonates most with you, about the different worship services of Holy Week?
