"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another. JUST AS I have loved you..." -John 13:34

No one had ever loved the way Jesus would love the <u>WORLD</u> those next three days.

The legend of the **PELICAN** 

"This is love...no one has ever <u>SEEN</u> God; if we love one another, God <u>ABIDES</u> in us and His love is <u>PERFECTED</u> in us."

-1 John 4:10, 12

Jesus showed us:

- How to love our <u>ENEMIES</u>, and pray for those who <u>PERSECUTE</u> us.
- That masters wash servants' feet, leaders are to <u>SERVE</u>, and the best kings are <u>SHEPHERDS</u>.
- That one who demonstrates true love will lay down his <u>LIFE</u> for others, and even die for the <u>UNRIGHTEOUS</u> (Romans 5:7-8).
- 4. That love is the <u>DEFINING</u>, <u>DISTINGUISHING</u> characteristic of those who follow Jesus.
- 5. That love is <u>MESSY</u>; among those He loved was a <u>BETRAYER</u> and <u>DESERTERS</u>.

No one had ever <u>MEASURED</u> <u>UP</u> to this standard of love until Jesus.
