SHARE

1. When you hear the words "perseverence" or "resilience," are there certain people and stories that come to mind? Spend a few minutes sharing.

READ

- 2. Read Job 1:13-22. Job became an object lesson for God and a test subject for Satan. How would you have responded if you were Job? Every instance of adversity we face in this life is an opportunity to either glorify God and grow closer to Him or to become more distant. Looking back at your life, what things have brought you closer to God?
- 3. Read Ephesians 6:10-20. God gives us defenses against the darkest, most evil powers in this world. What are they (go down the list), and why do they help? Is this glimpse into the unseen (usually) spiritual battle all around us scary or encouraging, and why?
- 4. Read Matthew 26:36-39. Jesus did not welcome suffering, but He submitted to it as He submitted to the Father's will. What can we learn from how Jesus suffered? What things can we put in our lives to prepare ourselves for suffering (how did Jesus prepare Himself?)?

5. How do you speak to someone who is struggling, suffering or facing adversity without sounding cliché or downplaying their problems? What works for you?
