SHARE

Name the "Mt. Rushmore" (top 4) of famous swords. What makes them famous?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

- 1. Read **Hosea 6:1-6**. God strikes down, and He binds us up; He kills and makes alive. How does this connect to the sword in the armor of God?
- 2. Read **Hebrews 4:11-13**. What do we learn about the Word of God in these verses?
- 3. Read **Matthew 10:34-39**. Jesus warns He came not to bring peace but a sword. What is He telling us?
- 4. Read James 4:7. The sword is an offensive weapon; how are we called to take on the devil?
- 5. Read **Acts 2:37**. Peter's preaching had the effect of cutting the people to the heart. What does that mean, and what happened after?
- 6. Read **Revelation 19:15**. Who is the rider on the white horse, and what do these images signify?
- 7. Read **Ephesians 6:19-20**. What have you learned about the armor of God in this series? What value does Paul place on prayer?
- 8. Martin Luther famously said, "To be a Christian without prayer is no more possible than to be alive without breathing." When we pray, we're not taking up a sword against a person, but rather against Satan on behalf of a person. How do you see this in your own life, and for whom can you be taking up arms?
