"While it was still <u>DARK</u> ..." (John 20:1)

- 1) <u>HOPE</u>.
- 2) <u>DEVOTION</u>.
- 3) **DESPERATION**.

"She <u>RAN</u> ... both of them were <u>RUNNING</u> together."

The empty tomb changes their **<u>DIRECTION</u>** and <u>SPEED</u>.

"But Mary stood weeping <u>OUTSIDE</u> the tomb..." (John 20:11a)

- Knew His **<u>POWER</u>**.
- Witnessed His <u>SUFFERING</u>.

"...and as she \underline{WEPT} she stooped to look into the tomb." (John 20:11b)

- The first to see Him <u>ALIVE</u>.

Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, "I have <u>SEEN</u> the Lord." (John 20:18)

"I have come into the world as light, so that whoever believes in me may not remain in <u>DARKNESS</u>." (John 12:46)
