#### **READ:**

### 1). Read Luke 2:1-7

- is there any part of this story that we read right through the details and fill in the gaps ourselves?
- "WHILE they were there" how does that word change the image we are used to seeing?
- Was there an INN and an Inkeeper? Only other place this word was used in Luke was in (22:11)
- 2). Whether Jesus was rejected because of overcrowding...or forced to be in discomfort in the middle of a mess...what is the main takeaway from the birth narrative?
- 3). Read Leviticus 26:11-12
  - God made his dwelling among us...and dwells amidst our mess.
  - How comfortable are you showing Jesus your mess?
- 4). Read Acts 5: 42
  - Going house to house. Each home is a temple where hope lives and joy grows.
  - How do you treat your home like a temple?

Pray: Lord, we ask that you would dwell in our mess...use our mess...as altar of your message...your gospel truth and hope and joy in our world.



# HOPE LIVES HERE: DOOR TO DOOR

Luke 2:1-7

"And <u>WHILE</u> they were there, the time came for her to give birth. And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the <u>INN</u>." Luke 2:6-7

καταλύματι – katalymati- <u>UPPER ROOM</u> πανδοχεῖον – pandocheion- <u>INN</u>

No innkeeper means Jesus likely wasn't dramatically turned away... instead He was placed in the very MIDDLE of a mess.

- Make ROOM in your hearts for us. 2 Cor. 7:2a
- "I will make my <u>DWELLING</u> among you, and my soul shall not abhor you. And I will walk among you and will be your God, and you shall be my people." Lev. 26:11-12
- "And every day, in the temple and from <u>HOUSE</u> to <u>HOUSE</u>, they did not cease teaching and preaching that the Christ is Jesus." Acts 5:42

The gospel is not just about getting everyone to church...it's about getting the church to **EVERYONE**.

This means: each door is an entrance to a <u>TEMPLE</u> where hope lives and each life is an <u>ALTAR</u> where joy grows.

Gospel <u>JOY</u> grows roots in our lives because it is not based on what's happening now...instead on what HAPPENED in the middle of a mess.
