1. What do you think of when you hear the word "sanctification?" Is it the townspeople from the movie "Footloose"? What does it look like to live a "sanctified" life without looking like a prude?

READ

- 2. Read Psalm 37:21-31. The picture this Psalm paints is that of a "righteous" life, where we turn from evil and do good. What benefit does this have as we seek to live with integrity with behavior that matches our beliefs?
- 3. Read Matthew 6:5-15. Jesus talks about quiet faithfulness, not that which draws attention to ourselves. In a world where we love to be seen, what is the benefit of this quiet faithfulness?
- 4. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:1-12. Paul repeats the phrase "more and more" with regard to the things he describes. How does it help to think of sanctification as a process, especially when you have setbacks?

5. Your life is on display. Whether you want it to be or not, you are a witness to what matters most to you. Pray for the Holy Spirit's strength in giving a faithful witness in word and deed to a world that needs it. Pray for God to open your eyes to opportunities to reflect Him to the world.
