How do you respond to God's "testing"? Is there a time that you look back on and see that God was testing you? What do you see God doing in and for you through that test?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

1. Read James 2:14-24 There are some people that wish this wasn't in the Bible because it seems to contradict our doctrine of "faith alone" and Ephesians 2:8-9. However, the author of James, is simply stating that faith is more that knowlege about a thing...faith is applied trust in a thing...specifically God. Faith sometimes gets tested...and moves from thought into action. How does faith impact your action?

2. Read Genesis 22:1-3

- a. How would you respond to this request?
- b. Why do you think Abraham has little hesitation? Even wakes up early. (Hebrews 11:17-19)

3. Read Genesis 22:4-8

a. What from this section points to Jesus? (3 days, carried wood on back, God would provide the lamb, went together/ submitted to the father,)

4. Read Genesis 22:9-14


a. What did Abraham call that place? How have you seen God provide in your life?

5. Read John 1:14-29

- a. v. 16 God provides "grace upon grace." How have you experienced an abundance of grace in your life?
- b. v. 29 "Behold the Lamb" How do these stories interconnect? (The lamb that Isaac was asking for John proclaimed! How cool)
