## Bible study for the week starting October 15, 2023

## SHARE

Who's the oldest person you've ever met? What are the blessings and curses of a long life?

## READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

1. Review Genesis 6:1-13. Spend some time on the description of human corruption at the time and focus on God's heartbreak because of it. How is this such a stark contrast to God's intention in creation?
2. Read Genesis 6:14-7:24. God gave detailed instruction for both the construction and the ark, which lends credibility to the factualness of the account. What's the repeated refrain about Noah's response? (How can you apply that to your own life?)
3. Doesn't this version of God come across as harsh? How do you reconcile this with the God who is elsewhere described as "gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faihtfulness?"
4. Read 1 Peter 3:18-22. Why does our church feel comfortable saying baptism saves you? (Some people don't like that much.)
5. Read Matthew 24:36-39. Jesus uses the flood story to highlight the need to "stay awake" for the return of Christ. Why is this important, and what does this look like?

PRAY
Pray for the faith to be confident in our salvation, even in times of judgment.
