SHARE

Think of a time when you were walking in hopelessness. Who met you along your journey?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

1. Read [Luke 24:13-15](#). These two men were on a long walk home...processing all the events that happened. How do you process traumatic events? (A walk and talk with a friend? Journaling? Prayer?)
2. Read [Luke 24: 16-24](#) Jesus draws them out to share by asking “What Things?” even though He already was really the ONLY person who really knew everything that happened. Why do you think He does this?
3. Read [Luke 24:25-27](#) Jesus then “interprets” ALL of the scriptures from Moses and the prophets to be about the Christ. Which verses do you think He used? Which stories did He say pointed to Him? (Genesis, Exodus, Psalms, Isaiah?)
 - a. Read [Isaiah 52:13-53:10](#). (While I don't know if Jesus discussed this passage...I have a feeling He did). Any others?
4. Read [Luke 24:28-35](#) Jesus finally reveals who He is in the breaking of the bread...something that Jesus did regularly...What was their response?
5. Read [Hebrews 12:1-3](#). They ran back 7 miles...to tell the disciples. Hope found legs. Where is Hope taking you?

PRAY

Pray for Hope to meet you in Hopelessness, for purpose to find you in your journey, and for the presence of the KING to transform your grief to JOY.
