SHARE:

All of our lives God is with us, but there are times where His voice and His presence become a little more recognizable to us. Whether through adversity, or being separated from your comfort zone. When have you heard or seen God the clearest? What impact did that have on you?

Why is it important that we don't just stay in those moments? (He didn't want Peter to set up a tent)

What did Jesus have planned for Peter instead? What does he have planned for you?

READ:

1). Read [Luke 9:18-20](#)

What did Jesus ask his disciples? And how did they respond? Why is this an important backdrop for what was about to happen on the Mount of Transfiguration?

3). Read [Luke 9:28-36](#)

What happens to Jesus? Who else was there? What does Peter want to do?

4). Read [Exodus 3:1-6](#)

God meets Moses on a Mountain. When else does God show up to Moses on a Mountain?

5). Read [1Kings 19:8-18](#)

Why does Elijah go to the mountain? What does he learn from God's whisper? (not alone)

6). Read [2 Corinthians 4: 5-12](#)

What is Paul reminding the church? When have you experienced affliction? Persecution? Etc?

7). Read [Luke 9:37](#)

What is the significance of Jesus coming back down the mountain?

Pray: Lord, help us clearly see Your glory in the FACE of Christ and His passion for us.
