
Reformation Sunday is NOT a Lutheran pep rally; it is a celebration of God's guidance of His Church through 2,000 years, and His correction/reformation of the church at different points along the way. If someone were to ask you what things you think God might want to reform in the Christian Church today, what might you say?

## **READ/STUDY/DISCUSS**

- 1. Read **Genesis 10 and 11** (or just **Genesis 11:1-9**). What was the "prideful rebellion" of these post-flood people?
- 2. What complications did this confusion of languages cause, that we are still dealing with today? What universal languages help bridge some of these communication gaps (Pastor Eric's example: worship!)?
- 3. Read **Romans 1:8-17**. "The righteous shall live by faith" is one of the transformational truths of the reformation. It was true for Adam, Noah, Abraham, and all that have followed. How does Satan, the enemy, try to erode at that truth?
- 4. Read **John 3:17-21**. You, of course, know the verse that precedes these verses. How does our doctrine of justification by grace through faith deliver us from what happens in these verses, where evil people hate the light, because it exposes their evil?
- 5. God promised He'd never again bring a flood to destroy the earth, because let's be honest we probably would've deserved it again by now. What does He do instead, to accomplish His holy purposes?
