What is the biggest change that has happened in your lifetime that you almost could not have predicted in your wildest dreams/nightmares (categories: culture, technology/inventions, politics, religion, etc.)?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

- 1. Read **Genesis 28:10-22.** Last time we left off was with Abraham's willingness to sacrifice his only-begotten son, Isaac. Now we join up with Jacob, Isaac's son. What had transpired in Jacob's life to this point? Where would God take him from there?
- 2. Jacob had a vision from God in a dream. What does the visions of angels on the ladder/stairs tell you, and what do you get out of God's words?
- 3. Jacob makes a commitment to God who affirmed his promises. What does Jacob promise, and how should our response to God be similar (or different)?
- 4. Read Romans 9:6-16. Paul calls the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob "children of the promise." What do you get out of this verse: "So then it depends not on human will or exertion, but on God, who has mercy"?
- 5. Read **Matthew 22:31-46**. We worship the "God of the living," who promises resurrection to us! What comfort do you get from knowing the God of Abraham is your God today? And what strength do you get form His presence and His promises?
- 6. Are you in a spiritual peak or valley today? Think back on some of those highs and lows. How can you look back and see God with you in the highs and lows?

PRAY

Pray that God would be with you in a tangible way in this new year, troubles and joys.



THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, ISAAC & JACOB: STAIRWAY FROM HEAVEN
