SHARE

When do you feel like worshipping? When do you not feel like worshipping? What do people see when you are going through a difficulty? Do they see whining or worship?

When do you feel most worshipful? Is it song/ prayer/ study that creates in you a worshipful and a humble heart?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

Read Acts 16: 16-24

- 1. What is the slave girl's problem? Why is Paul annoyed by her?
- 2. Is there anyone that annoys you so greatly that you would like to cast a demon out of them? (DON'T ANSWER! JUST A JOKE.)
- 3. Would you consider yourself a patient person? Could you use more patience?
- 4. Why are Paul and Silas arrested? Have you ever been wrongfully accused or received consequence that was simply unfounded?

Read Acts 16: 25-34


- 5. How do Paul and Silas behave once in jail? What else is happening in verse 25?
- 6. What have people seen about your witness when you have faced difficulty?
- 7. When do you worship? And who hears your worship?
- 8. What is the Jailer's response to the realization that they were still there? (Then the jailer treated Paul and Silas in a most unusual fashion for prisoners. He took them into his house and fed them at his own table. They were no longer prisoners in his eyes; they were brothers in Christ.)
- 9. What outward signs do you see of the jailer's conversion?

Read Acts 16: 35-40

10. Why does Paul want a public release?

PRAY

Pray that God would use whatever struggle you are going through as a way to grow closer to him, and as a way for others to see your faith in the midst.
