


Please review your messge notes and discuss with one another anything that especially impacted you from this week's message. And then read both of the primary texts once again for this teaching as listed above.

This lesson is about keeping our eyes on the truth and living in grace. Experiencing it ourselves and not intentionally or accidentally leading anyone else astray around us.

Read Galatians 2:1-14

- 1. What do verses 1 through 3 tell us about Titus?
- 2. By remaining uncircumcised, what was Titus declaring?
- 3. We don't want to slip into diagnostics in our assessment ... discuss this angle: By his action he was declaring, "Christ and His work are fully sufficient; I need not and cannot contribute anything of my own."
- 4. Why did Paul and Barnabas go to Jerusalem, taking Titus along with them?
- 5. Review with one another the purpose of and the results of the "Jerusalem Council" (can you find the account in your Bibles?)
- 6. Assuming you found it --- read Acts 15:5. According to Galatians 2: 4-5, what was the cause of the controversy over circumcision? How do you balance blame here? Is it fair to say that the Judaizers made Peter sin?
- 7. Discuss Paul's accusation of "false brothers" in Galatians 2:4. What does he mean by this title? What is the difference between a difference of opinion and a dangerous heresy? Discuss how some of these same discrepancies are a danger today? Can you list any in today's Christian Church?
- 8. If you're willing, discuss with one another any areas of your life where you wish someone would oppose you to your face to help you conquer this area of sin.

Prayer: Pray for and with each other, the big and the little stuff of life, and, that God would USE you and your life situations to impact people for eternal life WITH/IN Jesus.
