1. What does the ideal church look like? If the church was full of people just like you and your family, what would it look like? Would it be engaged? Growing? Full? Worshipful? Etc.?

- 2. Read Galatians 1:11-17. What drove Paul's actions before he received the Gospel of Jesus Christ? How does that compare with his current motivation?
- 3. Read Galatians 1:18-24. For what purpose did God choose Paul? With what authority did Paul preach the faith? What does it mean to be "apostolic"?
- 4. Paul is pretty vague about his preparation for ministry. We can speculate about *how* God accomplished this preparation during those 3 years, but what do you think God needed to deconstruct and reconstruct that took so long?
- 5. Paul is arguing for the authenticity of his message. How was he received by the other apostles, and why did they receive him so well?

> Our life is a case study in the TRANSFORMATIONAL power of the Gospel.

HURRICANE ties – the \$.67 difference.

If something is worth building, it's worth building <u>RIGHT</u>.

Paul is the poster child for zeal (<u>MISPLACED</u>)... <u>DESTROYED</u> the church of Jesus Christ. <u>VIOLENT OPPONENT</u> of the Gospel.

...who becomes the poster child for zeal (<u>PROPERLY PLACED</u>). <u>EXPANDED</u> the church of Jesus Christ. <u>PASSIONATE</u> <u>PROPONENT</u> of the Gospel.

MAN'S plans (Gamaliel) v. GOD'S plans (Gal. 1:15-17)

<u>APOSTOLIC</u> = passed down directly from <u>JESUS</u>

What would happen to the church if it was full of <u>YOUS</u>?

The best way to transform a church <u>COLLECTIVELY</u> is for us to also be transformed <u>INDIVIDUALLY</u>.

No one will <u>LISTEN</u> to what you have to <u>SAY</u> until they <u>SEE</u> the change and conviction in how you <u>LIVE</u>.
