



Bible study for the week starting May 24, 2026

SHARE

Think of a time when the timing of an event or an opportunity turned out almost perfect. How did you see God at work in this situation?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

1. Read [Acts 2:1-21](#) (or farther). What does this story reveal about how God gets people to faith and/or keeps them in the faith?
2. Peter tells the crowd, “The promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off.” What does this verse teach us about the heart of God in the scope and reach of salvation?
3. About 3,000 were baptized in one day. What does this miraculous result teach us about the power of the Holy Spirit and the importance of faithfully sharing God’s Word, even when we cannot predict the outcome?
4. Read [Numbers 11:24-30](#). God placed His Spirit on Moses, to which he replied, “Would that all the Lord’s people were prophets.” How is or isn’t Pentecost a fulfillment of this desire?
5. Read [John 16:4b-15](#). Jesus promises the Holy Spirit will convict people of their sin. Why is this conviction so necessary and such an important part of the work of the Holy Spirit?
6. The sermon described a “good day’s work” as showing up, being willing to be used by God, and remaining faithful. What is one situation this week where you can simply show up, trust the Holy Spirit, and be a witness to Christ?

PRAY

Thank God for the gift of the Holy Spirit and for the power of the Gospel to convict, forgive, and create faith. Ask Him to use your words, your presence, and your daily opportunities so that others may hear the good news of Jesus.
