

## Bible study for the week starting July 2, 2023

#### **SHARE**

I asked the question recently: If you couldn't live in the United States of America, in what country would you choose to live, and why? What is it that is good – and worth celebrating – about living in the U.S.?

### **READ/STUDY/DISCUSS**

- 1. Read 1 Samuel 8:4-22. No earthly government is perfect or holy; just look at this description of what the Israelites were in for when they wanted a king. We don't have a king in this country, but how do these descriptions resonate with what we give up as citizens of an earthly kingdom (the U.S.) in addition to a heavenly kingdom?
- 2. Read Romans 13:1-7. As it turns out, there haven't been a lot of warm, fuzzy empires over the past 2,000-6,000 years; clearly, not all are friendly or conducive to the free exercise of our Christian faith (Rome certainly wasn't). How do we operate under these responsibilities and restrictions? Why do you think it is that Christianity often grows the most under the most oppressive regimes?
- 3. Read Matthew 22:15-22. Jesus King of Kings and Lord of Lords was certainly beholden to no government, let alone Caesar; yet, Jesus instructed those who were trying to trap Him in His words to "render to Caesar." What does it mean to "render?" What do we "render" as Bakersfieldians, Californians, and Americans?
- 4. The second part and reason for this sermon of what Jesus said was, "Render to God what is God's?" What is God's, and how does that impact how we function in this world? We have different vocations; how would you rate yourself in your vocation as citizen, and how would you rate yourself in your vocation as Christian?

### **PRAY**

Pray together for our nation and our leaders, giving thanks to God for His blessings, repenting of our flaws, and asking for His guidance, grace and providence.
