READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

- 1. Read the ever so popular verse: Leviticus 14:33-42 What sticks out? That's a lot of detail. Could of chosen other laws.
 - a. Why do you think the bible has so many regulations in regards to cleanliness? How did this relate to holiness? (Lev. 19:2)
 - b. 613 laws plus more ^(C) Some are Ceremonial (worship and temple) Civil (Israelites as a unique community), and Moral (10 Commandments). Moral laws are repeated in NT and reflect the heart of God. How many have you broken?
- 2. Read Matthew 5:13-20
 - a. Jesus did not abolish but fulfilled it. Jesus is not lax on the law. He's actually more intense.
 - b. How does this coincide with Romans 10:4 and Galatians 3:24?
- 3. Read Galatians 6:2-9
 - a. There is freedom in Christ, but also a law of Christ. What is this law? (Maybe look at Matt 22:34-40)
