READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

- 1. Jewish custom was that the groom would prepare a room for the bride in his father's house. How does this custom impact how you read Read John 14:1-3.
 - a. Where else does this metaphor show up in scripture?
 - i. Isaiah 61:10; Isaiah 62:5
 - ii. Joel 2:16
 - iii. Matthew 25:1-13
 - iv. John 3:26-30
- 2. Read **Revelation 19:11-16**. What sticks out from the reading? Descriptions of Jesus that are striking? What is he wearing? What is he coming to do?
- 3. Read Isaiah 61:1-12 What is the juxtapostion of favor and judgement in Isaiah and in Revelation?
- 4. Read Rev 19:17-21. What is the outcome for the enemies of YHWH?

PRAY

Pray that we would remain faithful to the bridegroom, wait with hope and fulfill the purpose as the bride waits for the groom to return.

"Then came one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues and spoke to me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the wife of the LAMB." Revelation 21:9

"Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the <u>CHURCH</u> and gave himself up for her..." Eph. 5:25

"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. In my Father's house are many <u>ROOMS</u>. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to <u>PREPARE</u> a place for you?" John 14:1-2

<u>FAITHFUL</u>: We are not simply waiting for a <u>BETTER</u> option to trust...we are trusting Him as the only <u>GOOD</u> option in our waiting.

<u>PURPOSEFUL:</u> Being the Bride doesn't just mean people <u>ATTENDING</u> a church building on a weekend...it means the church attending to people <u>BUILDING</u> them up in their weakness.

<u>HOPEFUL:</u> Knowing that He is returning for me means my <u>PAST</u> struggles do not define me...my <u>PRESENT</u> suffering is truly temporary...and my <u>FUTURE</u> is secure and
