

Bible study for the week starting March 19, 2023

Included in this handout is a timeline of Paul's life and ministry. What would a timeline of your life look like?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

- Read Acts 21:27-39 (add 21:17-26 from last Wednesday, if you'd like). We see Paul's arrival in Jerusalem for Pentecost. The Old Testament significance was this was a celebration of God's giving of the Law/Torah/Instruction to Moses on Mt. Sinai; the New Testament significance is Pentecost was the birthday of the church. How does it being Pentecost contribute to the volatility of the situation as Paul entered Jerusalam?
- 2. In Paul's situation, the people repeated lies and gossip about him often enough and long enough that they became their truths. Satan is the "father of lies." What lies do we put on repeat in our life that subtly become our truths over time? How have you seen this happen in our culture, and how can these lies keep us from God?
- 3. Read **Colossians 2:6-15**. Paul was accused of throwing the law aside; does this passage sound like he's discounting the law? What do you hear when he says our debt is "nailed to the cross?"
- 4. Read John 9:1-7, 13-17, 34-49. This is the assigned Gospel reading from the lectionary for this Sunday. It's interesting that the people concluded someone must have had to have sinned to result in the man's blindness. Do we draw these conclusions today? How does Jesus re-frame the conversation?

PRAY

What an intimate gift it is to pray for one another. Hear the invitation of Jesus to cast all our anxieties and fears upon Him who cares for us.
