3. If you are not experiencing a joy-filled life, consider:
 - a. We have not experienced the salvation which produces it.
 - b. We have experienced it, but we have an immature understanding of what God wants for us.
 - c. A result of ongoing unconfessed sin in our life.
 - d. We embrace a misplaced focus. When the focal point of our desires is on self rather than who God is and what He wants for us, the joy of the salvation He has won for us diminishes. We might paraphrase the Lord's words in the Sermon on the Mount with this statement:
WHERE OUR TREASURE IS, OUR PLEASURE IS. *(Pastor Bob Deffinbaugh)*

May God enable us to find our joy in Him, and in Him alone.
