**Pastor Jimmy Davis Hubbard Jr.**

Jimmy Davis Hubbard Jr. was born into the world on January 20, 1972 in Meridian, MS. He is the son of Jimmy D. Hubbard Sr. and Ethel Mae Hubbard, and the second child of five (5) children. At six (6) months of age his parents moved to New Orleans because of his father's career as a brick mason. He spent his boyhood years in New Orleans, LA and at the age of 15 Jimmy Hubbard moved back to his birthplace (Meridian, MS) where he attended Northwest Jr. High and from there, he went on to attain his High School Diploma from Meridian High School. At the age of sixteen (16), Jimmy Hubbard came to know Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior while serving as a police cadet at Meridian Police Department.

In the beginning of 1992, Jimmy Hubbard entered the military under the delayed entry program and on May 27 he left for basic training. While serving his country Jimmy Hubbard was called into the Gospel ministry in 1996 under Pastor R. Williams at Camp Walker Chapel in Taegu, Korea. In 1996 Jimmy Hubbard was licensed into the Gospel ministry under the leadership of Pastor Obadiah Clemmons, Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church, of Meridian, MS. In 1998 Jimmy Hubbard was ordained under the leadership of Pastor Willie J. Freeman, Greater Missionary Baptist Church, of Clarksville, TN.

In the past 25 years Jimmy Hubbard has served in numerous capacities as Youth Pastor, Singles Ministry Director, Adult Sunday School teacher, Teacher for mid-week (evening) and mid-day (lunch time) Bible study classes, Vacation Bible School facilitator. as well as one of the Chief Care Ministers of under the leadership of Pastor Willie J. Freeman.

After 7 years of honorable service, Jimmy Hubbard left the military and matriculated through the halls of academia attaining several degrees stemming from: Automotive Technology (Tennessee Technology Center); Forensic Science (Peachtree University); Bachelor's in Business Administration with minor in Technical Writing (Austin Peay State University); Masters of Science Degree majoring in Human Services with a concentration in Counseling and Community Services (Capella University). In 2006 Jimmy Hubbard attained numerous semester hours towards a Master of Divinity Degree (Southern Baptist Theological Seminary).

In February of 2022, the Lord elevated Jimmy Hubbard to the pastorate of the Greater Missionary Baptist Church in Clarksville, TN affectionately known as "GMBC". In April of 2022 Pastor Jimmy D. Hubbard made history as he became the second (2nd) pastor of this passionate body of believers. Under Pastor Hubbard's leadership, the church has a newly renovated sanctuary and the church is growing spiritually and numerically. Also, under the leadership of Pastor Jimmy Hubbard the church has paid off and cancelled a 1.6 million dollar debt in 2 years...To God be the Glory!

Pastor Jimmy D. Hubbard has preached at numerous gatherings and in many settings and platforms around the world. He is a student of continuous learning, and he is a lifetime advocate for education and empowerment through the Word of God. Pastor Hubbard has one biological daughter (Japinica Hubbard) and two biological grandchildren Jamir Wilkerson and Jelani Lane as well as other surrogate children (Reneika Bailey and Shakeetra Tarver) and a host of grandchildren (Kae'Lanii Nedd, Jonathan Bell, Janiyah Bell, Elijah Range, Azariah Bailey, Jeremiah Blackmon, Nehemiah Bailey, and Hanna Smith whom he spends a lot of time with during his down time.

Pastor Jimmy Hubbard aspires to author books and be a role model specifically to men and young men by mentoring and discipling them in the things of God. Pastor Hubbard believes that Christians should enjoy life to the fullest and his favorite scripture is: Romans 8:28 "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose."



### Pastor Andre Richardson

Rev. M.A. Richardson is a native of Paris, TN. He is a 1987 graduate of Henry County High School. After high school, he attended Middle Tennessee State University in Murfreesboro, TN. In 1989 he joined the United States Marine Corps Reserve. This service led him to serve in the Gulf War, 1991. Upon returning from the Gulf War he felt God's call to Ministry. In the fall of 1991 at the Temple Baptist Church of Nashville, TN, he accepted the call to the Gospel Ministry and received his license to preach under the pastorate of Dr. Michael Lee Graves.

Rev. Richardson is formally an Associate Minister of the Temple Baptist Church of Nashville. There he served as Director of Public Relations, Director of the Minister's Fellowship, and Bible Class Teacher.

From 1994 – 1997 Pastor Richardson served as Assistant Director for the Baptist Student Union at Middle Tennessee State University. As Assistant Director his main duties were surrounded around working with the Black Student Fellowship of the BSU. God led him in 1995 to establish several different ministries at the BSU, which include: Intercessory Prayer, Drama, Evangelism, and Outreach Ministries. God really blessed the students through these ministries. This appointment also allowed Rev. Richardson to serve as an instructor in the National Baptist Student Union Retreat.

From 1999 till 2009 Pastor Richardson served as the Director of Baptist Student Ministries at Lane College, Jackson, Tennessee. This was a ministry of the Tennessee Baptist Missionary and Educational Convention. Through this ministry The Convention was able to secure a Baptist presence on a Christian Methodist Episcopal Campus. This was a need due to a great many of Lane students who were of Baptist origin.

Rev. Richardson was installed as Pastor of Mt. Zion Baptist Church in June of 1997. Upon being called as Pastor, the church gained over 120 new members in the first year and the membership continued it's growth down through the years. He led the church in remodeling the sanctuary and fellowship hall in 1998. In the following years he led the church in painting the outside of the church building and parsonage on Rison Street. In February of 1999 Pastor Richardson led the Mt. Zion Mass Choir in traveling to Disney World (Orlando, FL) to sing on the Bobby Jones Show which is a nationally television broadcast. He also started several new ministries including the Mother's Board, Brothers & Sisters in Christ, Nurses Guild, Food Bank, Clothing Center, Academic Excellence, Prayer Warriors, MANPOWER, Ladies In Training, Women of Worth, and Church in the Park Outreach Ministries.

In 2010 the 304 Rison Street location began to experience aging issues with the building structure. This forced the Church to move in the Spring of 2011, and for 6 ½ years the Church met at the Krider Performing Arts Center of Paris, TN. In March of 2017 Pastor Richardson lead Mt. Zion in the purchase of our present location at 401 Irvine Street Paris, TN. In the past 6 years, at the new location and through a Worldwide Pandemic, the Church has still continued to grow both numerically and spiritually.

Pastor Richardson has two children: Andrea Velise Richardson, and Maury Andre' Richardson Jr. both of Nashville, Tennessee. Pastor Richardson has traveled extensively to preach and teach the Gospel. His heart is in ministering the truth of God's word to a hurting world.
