The Manipulating Leader (Abner)

<u>2 Samuel 2:8–9</u> "8 But Abner the son of Ner, captain of Saul's host, took Ish-bosheth the son of Saul, and brought him over to Mahanaim; 9 And made him king over Gilead, and over the Ashurites, and over Jezreel, and over Ephraim, and over Benjamin, and over all Israel."

<u>2 Samuel 3:6</u> "6 And it came to pass, while there was war between the house of Saul and the house of David, that <u>Abner made himself strong for the house of Saul</u>."

<u>Proverbs 6:24–25</u> "24 To keep thee from the evil woman, From the flattery of the tongue of a strange woman. 25 Lust not after her beauty in thine heart; Neither let her take thee with her eyelids."

<u>Psalm 36:1–3</u> "1 The transgression of the wicked saith within my **heart**, That there is no fear of God before his eyes. 2 For **he flattereth himself in his own eyes**, **Until his iniquity be found to be hateful**. 3 The words of his mouth are iniquity and deceit: He hath left off to be wise, and to do good."

Romans 16:18 "18 For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple."

1 Samuel 26:12–16 (KJV 1900)

- ¹² So David took the spear and the cruse of water from Saul's bolster; and they gat them away, and no man saw *it*, nor knew *it*, neither awaked: for they *were* all asleep; because a deep sleep from the Lord was fallen upon them.
- ¹³ Then David went over to the other side, and stood on the top of an hill afar off; a great space *being* between them:
- ¹⁴ And David cried to the people, and to **Abner** the son of Ner, saying, Answerest thou not, **Abner**? Then Abner answered and said, Who *art* thou *that* criest to the king?
- ¹⁵ And David said to Abner, <u>Art not thou a valiant man</u>? and who *is* like to thee in Israel? wherefore then hast thou not kept thy lord the king? for there came one of the people in to destroy the king thy lord.

¹⁶ This thing *is* not good that thou hast done. *As* the Lord liveth, <u>ye are worthy to die,</u> <u>because ye have not kept your master, the Lord's anointed</u>. And now see where the king's spear *is*, and the cruse of water that *was* at his bolster.

Ephesians 5:22-6:9.

- 2 Samuel 2:23 "23 Howbeit he refused to turn aside: wherefore Abner with the hinder end of the spear smote him under the fifth rib, that the spear came out behind him; and he fell down there, and died in the same place: and it came to pass, that as many as came to the place where Asahel fell down and died stood still."
- <u>2 Samuel 23:22–24</u> "22 These things did <u>Benaiah</u> the son of Jehoiada, and had the name among three mighty men. 23 He was <u>more honourable than the thirty</u>, but he attained not to the first three. And David set him over his guard. 24 <u>Asahel the brother of Joab was one of the thirty</u>; Elhanan the son of Dodo of Beth-lehem,"
