**He Lamented**-2 Samuel 1:17 "17 And David lamented with this lamentation over Saul and over Jonathan his son:"

<u>2 Samuel 1:23</u> "23 Saul and Jonathan were lovely and pleasant in their lives, And in their death they were not divided: They were swifter than eagles, They were stronger than lions."

Hebrews 12:1 "1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,"

## II. HE SET BOUNDARIES

Daniel 1:8 "8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself."

Job 31:1 "1 I made a covenant with mine eyes; Why then should I think upon a maid?"

Psalm 101:3 "3 I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes: I hate the work of them that turn aside; it shall not cleave to me."

### III. HE MOVES CAUTIOUSLY

#### B. TIME TO PROCESS

<u>2 Samuel 1:12</u> "12 And they mourned, and wept, and fasted until even, for Saul, and for Jonathan his son, and for the people of the Lord, and for the house of Israel; because they were fallen by the sword."

"IF THE ANSWER IS NOW THE ANSWER IS NO"

#### C. TRUE PRINCIPLES
