The World affects HOW we think and WHAT we treasure

-

1 Samuel 8:5 — “Look, you are old, and your sons do not walk in your ways. Now make us a king to judge us like all the nations.”

Hebrews 13:4 — Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.

1 Corinthians 6:9-10 — Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.

-

1980 — Transsexualism and related gender identity categories first appear in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders

-2000 — All gender variance diagnoses are consolidated under “Gender Identity Disorder (GID),” still within the mental disorders chapter.

-2013 — The American Psychiatric Association renamed “Gender Identity Disorder” to “Gender Dysphoria.” (The focus shifted from a “disorder” to a “distress or impairment.”)

-2019 — The World Health Organization moved “Gender Incongruence” out of the Mental and Behavioral Disorders chapter, placing it instead in the “Conditions related to sexual health.”

Lot & Sodom

Lot was righteous, but Sodom was wealthy. Look at what happened to his family.

2 Peter 2:7-8 — and delivered righteous Lot, who was oppressed by the filthy conduct of the wicked (for that righteous man, dwelling among them, tormented his righteous soul from day to day by seeing and hearing their lawless deeds)

Ezekiel 16:49 — “Look, this was the iniquity of your sister Sodom: She and her daughter had pride, fullness of food, and abundance of idleness; neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.

The Destruction of Sodom & Gomorrah  
Genesis 13:8-13

Genesis 19:14 — So Lot went out and spoke to his sons-in-law, who had married his daughters, and said, “Get up, get out of this place; for the LORD will destroy this city!” But to his sons-in-law he seemed to be joking.
