ENEMY OPERATES ON "BORROWED TIME" - VICTORY ALREADY SECURED AT THE CROSS!

THE THREE GREAT SIGNS

1. THE WOMAN (GOD'S PEOPLE)

STEPHANOS (VICTOR'S CROWN)



- ISRAEL AND THE CHURCH; BELIEVERS ARE "GRAFTED IN" AS CO-HEIRS.
- KEEP GOD'S COMMANDMENTS AND HOLD TO THE TESTIMONY OF JESUS.

2. THE CHILD (JESUS CHRIST)



- THE PROMISED MESSIAH WHO RULES THE NATIONS.
- HIS BIRTH, ASCENSION, AND VICTORY TIE THE ENTIRE BIBLE TOGETHER.

3. THE DRAGON (SATAN)



- A DEFEATED ADVERSARY.
- USES FALSE AUTHORITY RATHER THAN THE VICTOR'S CROWN.

1/3 OF STARS	A MINORITY PORTION OF FALLEN ANGELS; HIS INFLUENCE IS LIMITED.

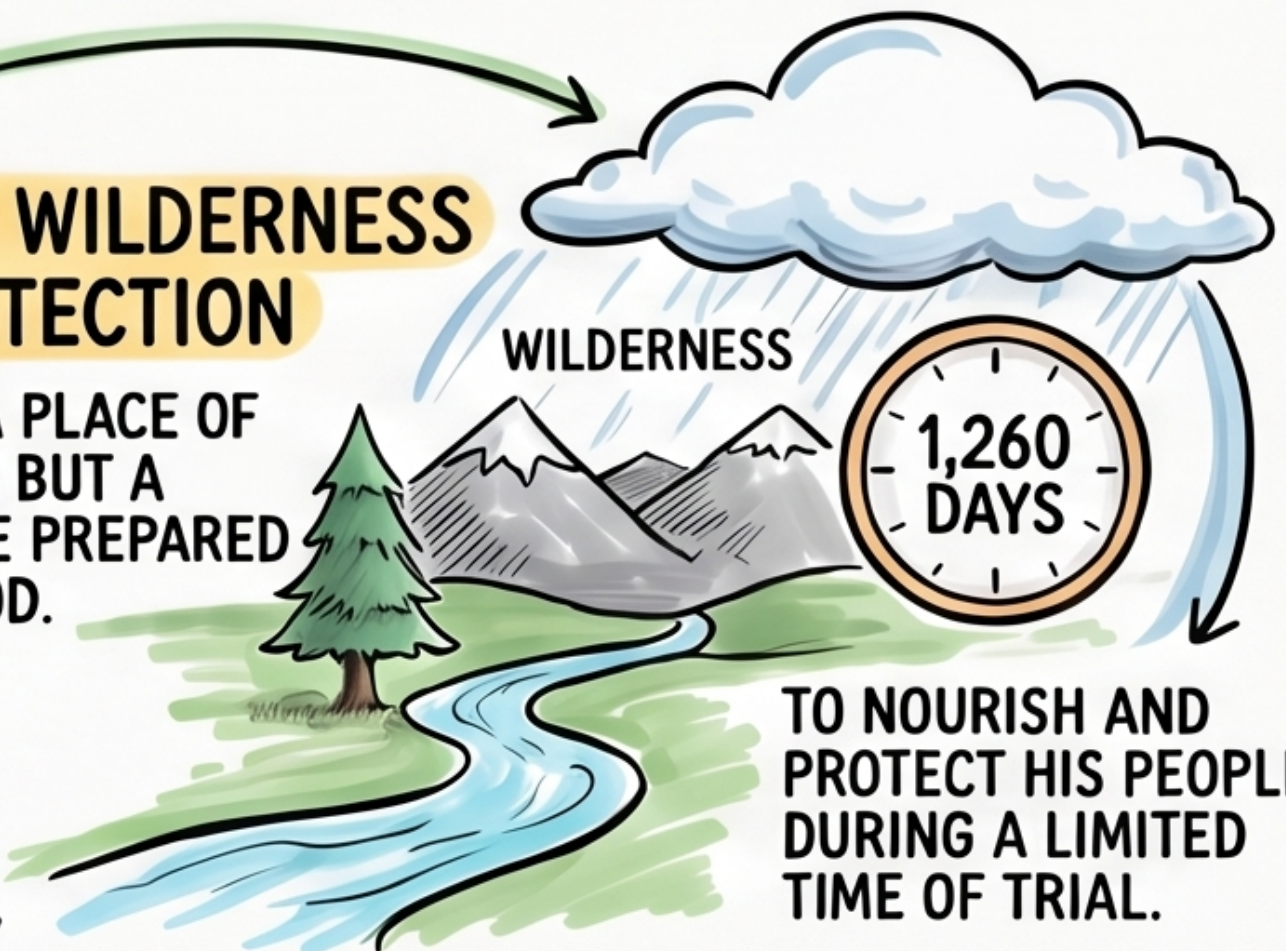

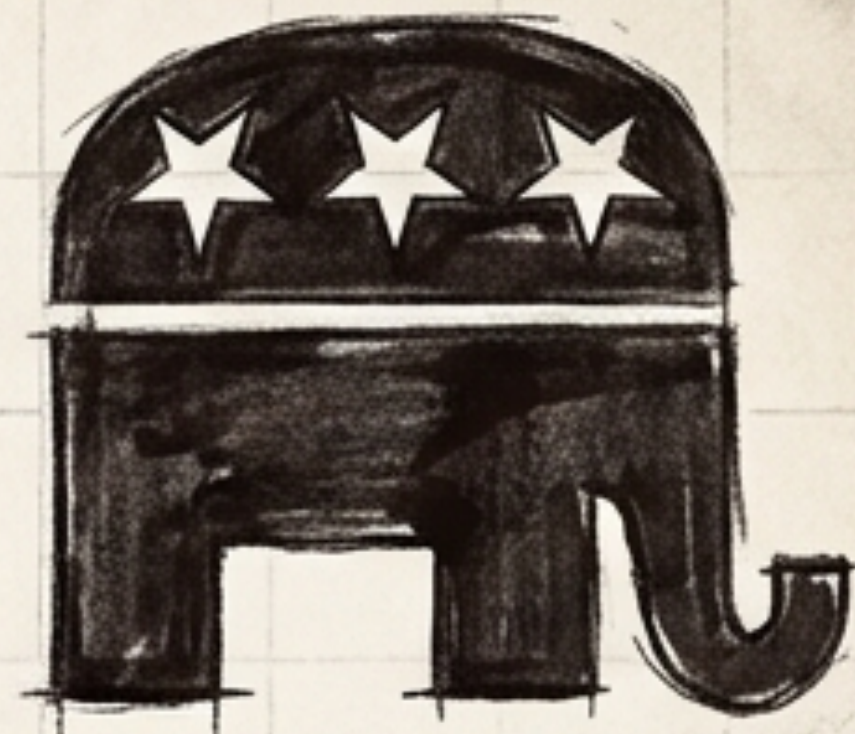
The Signpost Principle



*Literal. Meaningless
outside of context.*



Points beyond itself.



*A Sign. Carries deep
history, emotion, and
ideological power.*

Revelation does not give us a literal photograph. It gives us divine signs. We have the scripture and the Spirit to decode them.

Revelation 12:1-2

A great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars; 2 and she was pregnant and she cried out, being in labor and in pain to give birth.

Revelation 12:17

17 So the dragon was enraged with the woman, and went off to make war with the rest of her children, who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus.

Subject 01: The Woman

If literal, history falls apart. When did Mary flee into the wilderness chased by a dragon?

As seen in Isaiah 54 and Jeremiah 31, Israel is depicted as a woman. But Romans 11 reveals we have been grafted into the rich root of the olive tree.

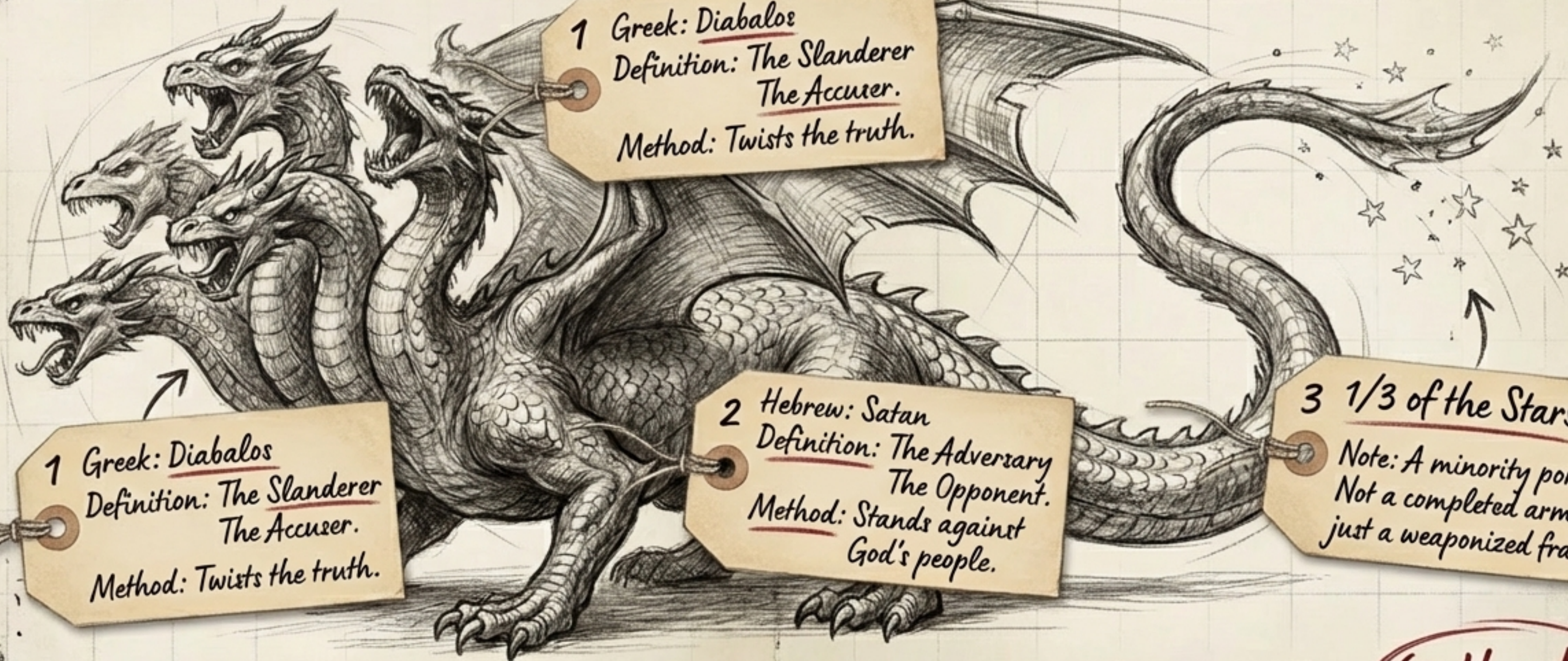
*We are not unwanted children.

3 Then another sign appeared in heaven: and behold, a great red dragon having seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads were seven crowns.

4 And his tail *swept away a third of the stars of heaven and hurled them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she gave birth he might devour her Child.

Subject 02: The Enemy's Dual Nature



1 Greek: Diabalos
Definition: The Slanderer
The Accuser.
Method: Twists the truth.

1 Greek: Diabalos
Definition: The Slanderer
The Accuser.
Method: Twists the truth.

2 Hebrew: Satan
Definition: The Adversary
The Opponent.
Method: Stands against
God's people.

3 1/3 of the Stars.
Note: A minority portion.
Not a completed army,
just a weaponized fraction.

Accuser + Adversary = Complete, organized opposition (7 Heads)
But operating on borrowed time.



DIADEM

A royal crown. Claimed, taken, and assumed. Represents fake authority, pride, and arrogance.



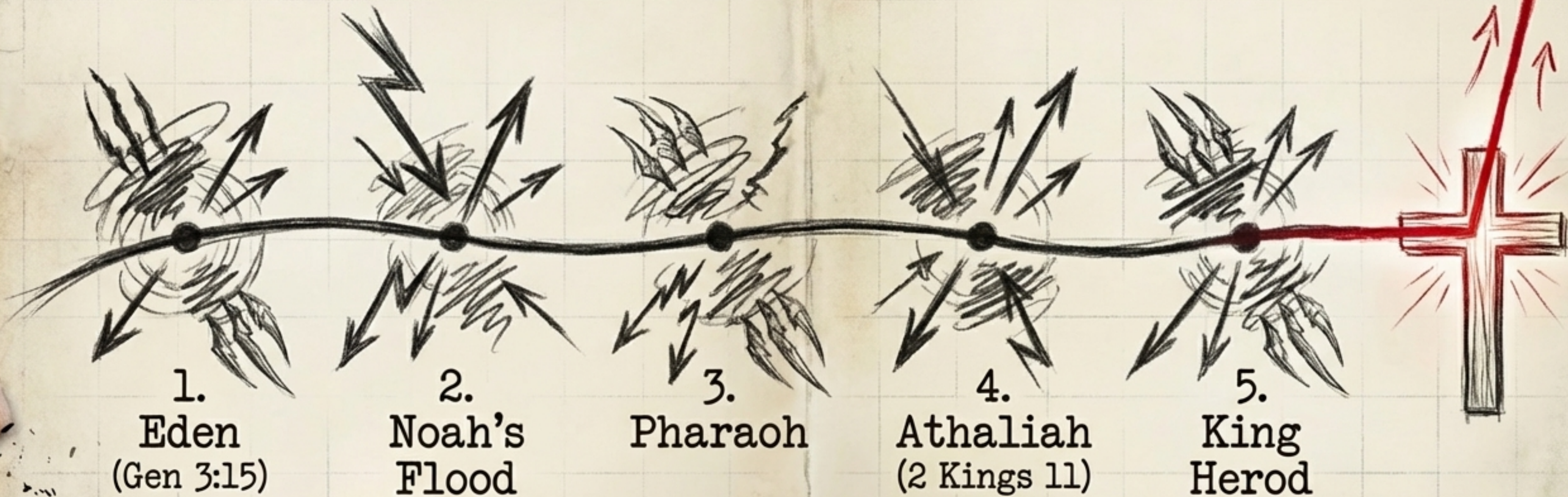
STEPHANOS

A victor's wreath. Given, earned, and inherited. Represents true, delegated authority from God.

*He fiercely claims what he cannot earn.
She is freely given what she could never claim.*

Subject 03: The Child & The Line of Survival

“And her child was caught up to God,
and to his throne.” (Rev 12:5)



Every attempt to sever the line failed.
The battle for survival is over.

Revelation 12:5

5 And she gave birth to a Son, a male, who is going to rule all the nations with a rod of iron; and her Child was caught up to God and to His throne.

Genesis 3:15

And I will make enemies
Of you and the woman,
And of your offspring and her Descendant;
He shall bruise you on the head,
And you shall bruise Him on the heel.”

Rev 12:6

6 Then the woman fled into the wilderness where she *had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished for 1,260 days.

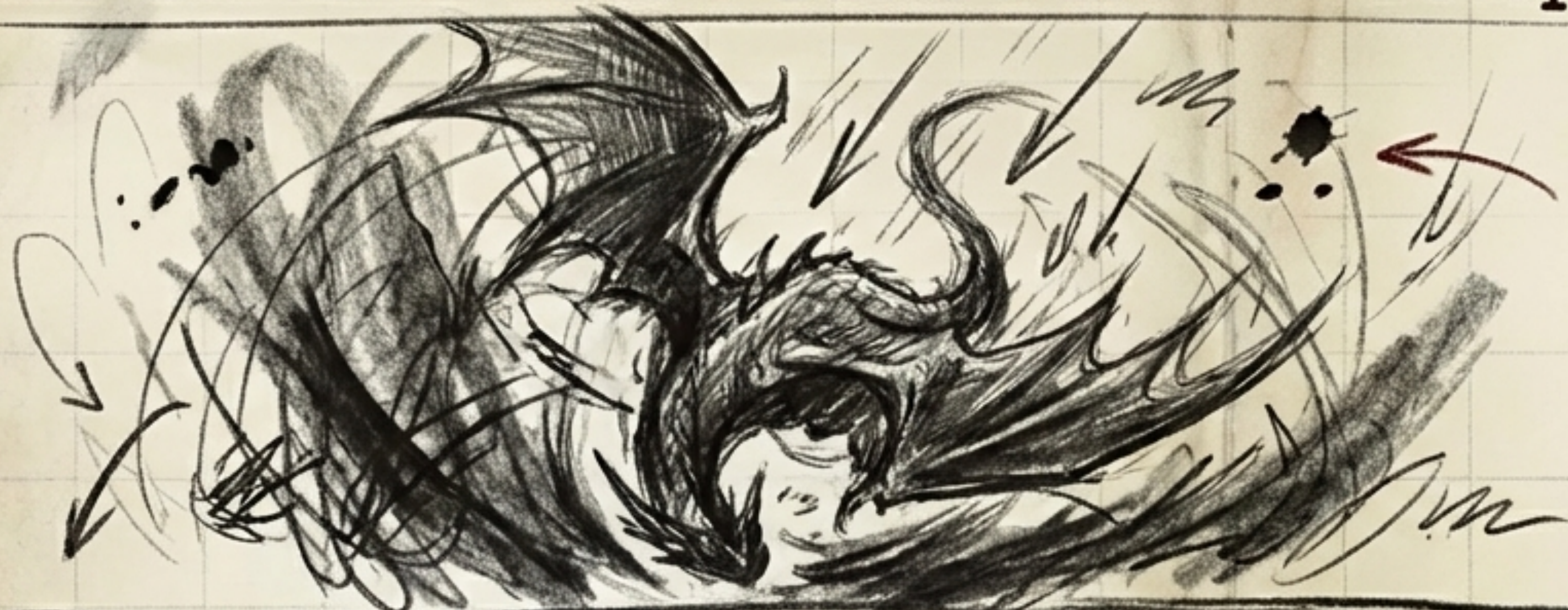
Rev 12:7–9

7 And there was war in heaven, Michael and his angels waging war with the dragon. The dragon and his angels waged war, 8 and they did not prevail, and there was no longer a place found for them in heaven. 9 And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

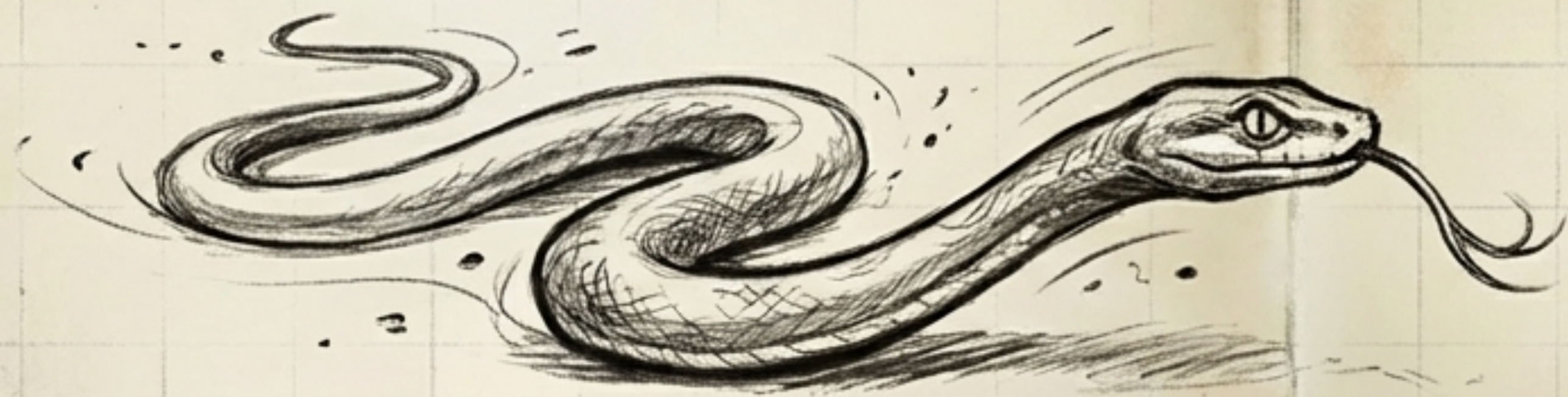
Rev 12:10

10 Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying,
“Now the salvation, and the power, and the
kingdom of our God and the authority of His
Christ have come, for the accuser of our brothers
and sisters has been thrown down, the one who
accuses them before our God day and night.

The Tactical Shift: From Force to Deception



Cast down. The Accuser has lost his legal standing in heaven (John 12:31).



Notice the text changes from Dragon to Serpent. He no longer operates by brute force or outright war.

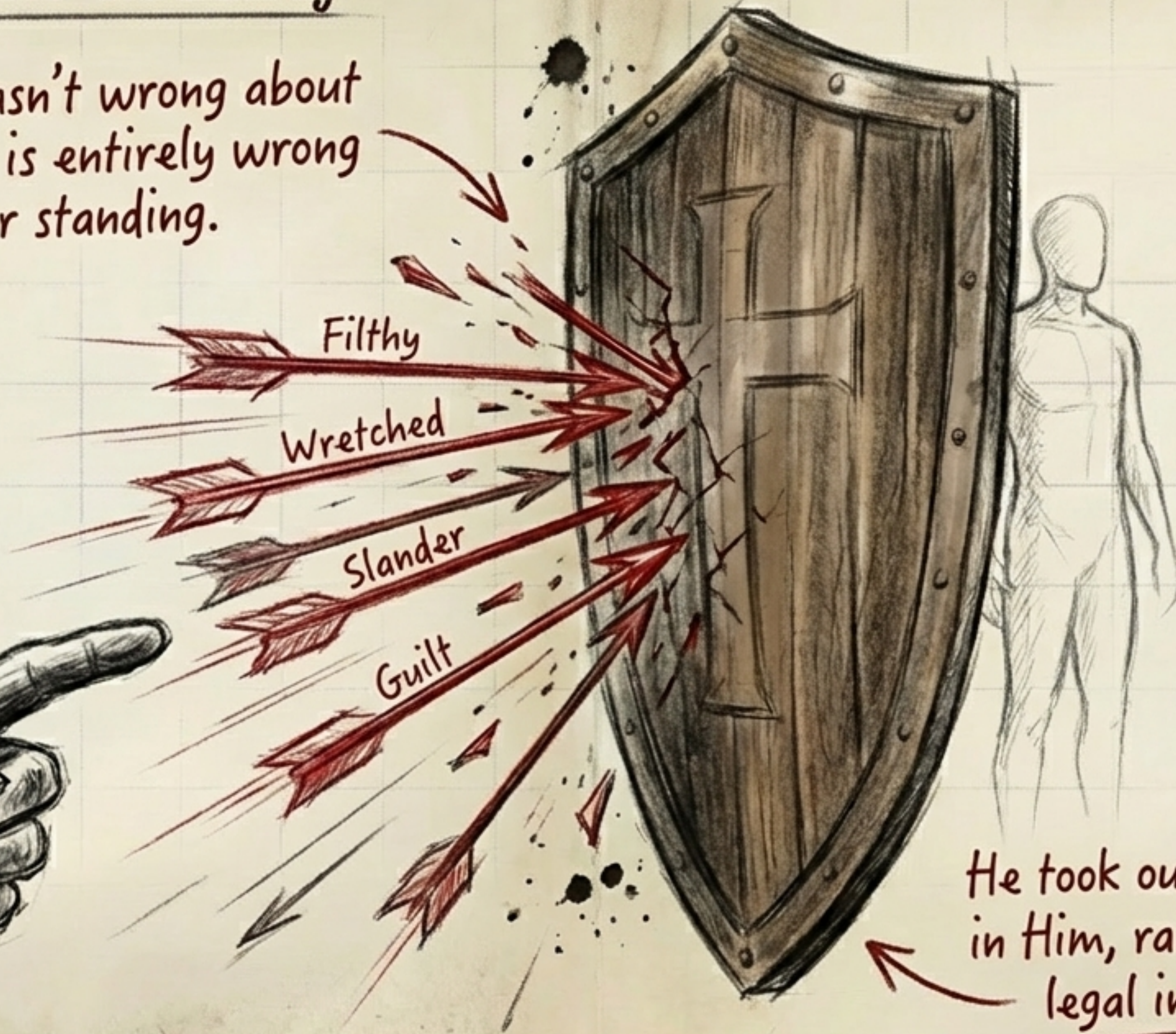
Defeated in the heavens, restricted on earth. He can now only attack the gathered church through subtle deception, lies, and perversion.

1,260 Days = 3.5 years.
A symbolic, severely limited season.

The Courtroom Reality

The Accuser wasn't wrong about our sin. But he is entirely wrong about our standing.

"Satan standing at his right to accuse him."
(Zechariah 3)



"There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."
(Romans 8:1)

He took our place. We are hidden in Him, raised perfect, with zero legal indebtedness (Col 2:14).

Rev 12:11

11 And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.

Rev 12:12-13

12 For this reason, rejoice, you heavens and you who dwell in them. Woe to the earth and the sea, because the devil has come down to you with great wrath, knowing that he has only a short time.”

13 And when the dragon saw that he was thrown down to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male Child.

Rev 12:14-15

14 But the two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, so that she could fly into the wilderness to her place, where she *was nourished for a time, times, and half a time, away from the presence of the serpent. 15 And the serpent hurled water like a river out of his mouth after the woman, so that he might cause her to be swept away with the flood.

A Prepared Place, An Armed People

Redefining the Wilderness:
In reality, wild and unsafe.
In scripture, where God provides
(Manna, Cloud, Fire).



We are not fleeing in fear.
We are fleeing to safety.

How we overcome (Revelation 12:11):

1. The Blood of the Lamb: The finished work of the Cross.
2. The Word of our Testimony: Martyria. Our spoken declaration of truth, held tighter than our own comfort or self-preservation.

The battle has shifted from a fight for survival to a fight for truth.
We are sheltered. We are armed. The victory is secure.

Rev 12:16-17

16 But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and drank up the river which the dragon had hurled out of his mouth. 17 So the dragon was enraged with the woman, and went off to make war with the rest of her children, who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus.
