“WHAT’S IN A COVENANT” GENESIS 15:1–21



START HERE

In case you are in a group with people you haven't met before, begin by introducing yourselves and sharing an interesting detail about yourselves. (you can skip this part if you all know each other)

Then, check in with each through HGIWYS “How goes it with your soul?” (How is your relationship God? What do you feel God is doing or saying in specific areas of your life? family, work, friendships, etc.)

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER:

We share from a place of vulnerability and authenticity. We come as we are, believing that God embraces us as we are. So we too embrace each other as we are.
We hold each other's words in confidence and prayer. What we share in group remains in the group. We carry these words only within ourselves so we may pray for our siblings in Christ throughout the week.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS BASED ON THE MESSAGE

- > Can you think of a promise your parents made when you were young that was never fulfilled? Have you ever broken a promise?
- > If you were in Abram's shoes and wanting assurances for the promises God has made, what would have been sufficient for you?
- > Is there a relationship in your life today that exists only because of someone's generosity of Grace? What would have happened in the absence of grace?
- > What is the greatest difficulty in practicing 'Grace' through your (closest) relationships (maybe as you imagine that person that demands the most grace from you)? How can others pray for you?

After everyone has had the chance to share, please take turn to share your prayer requests. After sharing your prayer requests, a person from the group should pray and close out the group time.
