HANG OUT (warming up to the topic)

- 1. Take time to review this week's teaching and discuss your reactions. Talk about what most challenged, puzzled, and encouraged you.

3. Read Matthew 6:5-8

Leaders Notes: A couple of big ideas from the teaching to keep in mind

- Prayer isn't just about changing things. It's about being changed.
- The goal of prayer isn't to get God to do something. It's about getting God.
- What verse or idea stands out to you and why?
- Why do you think when Jesus teaches on prayer he starts with *where*? Where do you do most of your praying?
- How does it make you feel to know that God values time and place over the words we use?

HUDDLE (making it personal and praying together)

- 4. In light of Jesus' teaching on prayer, how should your daily prayers change?
- 5. Let's hold each other to a shared commitment this week to pick a time and a private place to pray at least twice this week. The next time we meet, we will share how we did and our experience with it.
