### *The Life-Giving Power of Humility* Alan Kraft, Lead Pastor

#### Icebreaker

What's your favorite meal to cook (or to eat) and why?

When is the last time you enjoyed doing this?

#### Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Philippians 2:5-11 a couple of times, in different Bible translations if possible.

What words, phrases, or insights stand out to you from these verses, or create some awe for you in terms of Jesus' identity and humility?

What uniquely spoke to you from Pastor Alan's message on these verses on Sunday?

In general, how did the message help you get a better grasp on the power of humility in our relationships or spheres of influence?

Who is a person that you believe exemplifies humility? (either someone you know personally, have worked with/for, a current public servant, or historic figure)

How have you seen their humility make a positive difference in their relationships, leadership, and/or overall effectiveness?

How has their humility inspired you personally?

Revisit the three characteristics of humility exemplified by Jesus in this week's verses, and specific ways we see Him living out each of these things during His ministry here on earth ...

Be secure in your own identity (verse 6)

An eagerness to live for the sake of others (verse 7)

Submitting our will to the Father's will (verses 8-11)

What situation for you poses the greatest challenge to your humility right now?

How do you see these characteristics coming into play in terms of responding to this challenge?

How do these verses, in partnership with this week's message and group discussion, inspire you to greater humility?

In response, is there anything specific that the Holy Spirit is prompting you to do or to change to put this into practice this week?

How might fixing your eyes on Jesus empower you to do this?

Conclude by praying for one another in applying this week's insights and Spirit-promptings, as well as for general needs and concerns.
