How to Use This Guide in a Group Setting

Group Participants: Review your notes from the message and ask the Holy Spirit to continue to speak to you about your life. Come to eGroup prepared to participate. Watch the message online if you missed it live.

Group Leaders: Give everyone the chance to share, focusing on the questions that connect most with your group. Don't feel you must answer every question. If someone missed the message, allow time for others to fill them in on the main points and highlights.

Getting Started

Have you ever had to sell something door-to-door, or make sales calls on people who weren't expecting you?

If so, briefly describe this experience and what it was like for you.

If not, what do you imagine it would be like for you to do this?

Embrace the Gospel

In our eGroup discussion guides, we're utilizing a simple structure for studying the Bible together, based on the acronym S.O.A.P. ...

Spirit: *Invite The Holy Spirit To Speak To You and To Guide Your Discussion*

Begin by praying and inviting the Spirit's activity into your discussion and application of God's Word.

Observation: *What Does This Passage Say?*

Read aloud Luke 10:1-16.

What stands out to you from these verses (in terms of words, phrases, themes, personalities, interactions, etc.), or stood out to you from this week's message on these verses? What questions do they raise, or surprises do they contain?

What do you find most compelling in these words from Jesus?

How do you imagine you'd feel and respond if you were among the seventy-two people receiving these instructions from Jesus?

What specific things can we learn from these verses ...

About Jesus' values and priorities, and what's involved in His followers living them out within their sphere of influence today?

Embrace the Gospel Continued

About what could potentially interfere with this occurring?

About what's involved in cooperating more fully with Jesus in mission?

Application: *What Is God Saying To Me?*

Where do you feel you most need to experience Jesus' recalibration these days? Explain.

At a Heart Level

In the Orientation of My Life

In My Perception of God

What would it look like for this to occur for you?

In what other ways is God stirring your heart in response to these verses, and what next step might be involved in you responding to Him in this?

Experience the Spirit

Prayer: Ask For God's Help In Living Out His Word

Begin by praying for things that have surfaced and been discussed as a part of your eGroup discussion this week.

When done praying for these things, spend time praying for general needs and concerns for one another.

Engage in Mission

As we heard in this weekend's message, it's our desire that every eGroup would compassionately move toward people who are lost, needy, and broken, demonstrating the love of Jesus in highly relational ways. One size doesn't fit all, however, in terms of how our various groups accomplish this vision, including yours.

If you've never done it before (or for awhile), as a group consider processing some of the following talking-points:

- Who are some people around you that aren't yet in a relationship with God?
- How can you be incorporating these people – their needs and relationship with God -- into your regular eGroup prayer time?
- How can you and your eGroup be used of God in helping these people experience Jesus more fully and enter into a relationship with Him?
- What's one specific step you and your eGroup can take in relationally moving toward these people?
