#### Icebreaker

What's the best team you've ever been a part of, and why?

How did you uniquely contribute to this team's efforts and success, and complement the other members of this team in the process?

#### Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Ephesians 4:1-6 a couple of times, in different Bible translations if possible. What strikes you or intrigues you the most from these verses ... words, phrases, concepts, or other things?

What stood out to you from Mariana's message on these verses this weekend, or what specific things did you personally take away from her message?

How would you summarize the main point of this weekend's message in one sentence?

This weekend we launched a new series of messages in Ephesians entitled, "Walk: Turning Faith Into Action."

What aspects of your faith are easiest to translate into action, and which are more challenging? Why do you think this is?

In her message, Mariana said, *"Humility is not thinking less of yourself; it's thinking of yourself less ... it's being divorced from your obsession with yourself."*

How do you feel about these definitions?

In what ways does our growth in humility not only benefit us, but ultimately benefit others as well?

Likewise, Mariana described patience as not just being able to wait, but your attitude while waiting.

Given this definition, how patient are you ... and how well do you handle interruptions?

In practical terms, what do unity and oneness look like when being lived out in our heart and relationships? What do they not look like? (verses 3-6)

What's your biggest challenge in fully experiencing unity and oneness with other people?

Where do you long to grow in more fully living out your faith, and what's the next step for you in doing this?
