Icebreaker

Do you have a "happy place?"

If so, where is it, and what is it about this place that brings you joy?

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Ephesians 4:7-16 a couple of times, in different Bible translations if possible. What strikes you or intrigues you the most from these verses ... words, phrases, concepts, or other things?

What stood out to you from Pastor Alan's message on these verses, or what specific things did you personally take away from his message?

How would you summarize the main point of this weekend's message in one sentence?

Looking back, what things have contributed the most to your spiritual growth, and how have they done this? Is there anything you wish you'd done differently so far to grow spiritually?

How did this week's message affirm or challenge your understanding of what's involved in your spiritual growth moving forward?

Why is grace such a vital part of the spiritual growth process, both personally and in community with others? (verses 7-13, 16; Ephesians 3:7)

How fully do you feel you grasp and apply God's grace in your own spiritual growth? In your relationship with other Christ-followers?

In his message, Pastor Alan challenged a consumeristic approach to our personal engagement with the church.

How do you feel about what he said?

Do you ever struggle with being more of a consumer than a contributor? Explain.

What are your spiritual gifts, and how do you see them influencing your unique contribution in ministry to others within our larger church family and/or your small group?

Re-read verses 14-16. Where do you long to grow in grace and/or truth these days, and in what ways do you see your small group contributing to this occurring?

How might your small group be even more of an influence on one another's spiritual growth in the months to come?
