


MAPS & PARKING

TVCC BUILDING MAP


Upstairs

CELEBRATE RECOVERY is a place to fellowship and celebrate God's healing power in our lives through the "8 Recovery Principles." By working and applying these 8 Biblical principles, we begin to grow spiritually. We become free from our addictive, compulsive and dysfunctional behaviors. This leads to a stronger relationship with God and others.



Celebration Place is the approved children's curriculum for Celebrate Recovery ministries for ages 6-12. This Christ-centered curriculum taught in Large Group for adults. We refer to it as our "Pre-Covery" program.
