**CELEBRATE RECOVERY** is a place to fellowship and celebrate God's healing power in our lives through the "8 Recovery Principles." By working and applying these 8 Biblical principles, we begin to grow spiritually. We become free from our addictive, compulsive and dysfunctional behaviors. This leads to a stronger relationship with God and others.



**THE LANDING** is an ongoing 52-week program for teens 13-17, with engaging videos, meaningful experiences, vibrant worship, and great conversation as they develop true friendships with other teens. The Landing is a safe, healing place where teenagers can live a freer, healthier, and more God-centered life.



**CELEBRATION PLACE** is the approved children's curriculum for Celebrate Recovery ministries for ages 6-12. This Christ-centered curriculum mirrors the lessons taught in Large Group for adults. We refer to it as our "Pre-Covery" program.
