Thanks for giving me this opportunity to share my testimony.

my name is Rajubabu Kommu from India. I was blessed to be born into a Christian family — both my father and grandfather served as pastors. From childhood, I had a close relationship with God and began serving Him as a Sunday school teacher. Even then, God gave me a vision to help children and widows, especially in the areas of education and nutrition.

However, my journey was not easy. Our family faced many financial and spiritual struggles, especially living among unbelievers. After completing my post-graduation, I took baptism following three days of fasting prayer. On that day, I dedicated myself fully to God and began to ask Him: “Lord, what is my role in Your ministry?”

For many days I waited, and one night at 11:30 p.m., the Holy Spirit led me into prayer. During that time, God gave me a clear vision. I saw myself sharing the Gospel with people I had never met, in places I did not even know. The Lord spoke to me and said, “I have chosen you to expand My Kingdom in India, to fulfill the Great Commission, to make disciples, and to reach the unreached through church planting.”

From that moment in 2016, I began focusing on village ministry. I started with five women leaders and five village pastors, and together we began church planting and discipleship programs. It was not easy, because I had no resources, but I kept praying: “Lord, please bring the right people to collaborate with me in this mission.”

God answered that prayer through ILF, which became a great blessing. Through this partnership, the vision of community transformation began to grow. Today, by God’s grace, we are helping children receive education for a brighter future and supporting widows who have been neglected, while continuing the work of church planting and discipleship.

All this is not my work, but the work of God, who is greatly impacting lives and expanding His Kingdom in India. I am deeply grateful for your prayers and loving support. Together, we are seeing lives transformed for the glory of God.
