

## Calling on the Name of the Lord

Acts 2:21 And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'

Romans 10:13 for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

## The Word of God

Acts 11:14 He will bring you a message through which you and all your household will be saved.

1 Corinthians 15:2 By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you.

James 1:21 Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you.

## Jesus

John 10:9 I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved.

## Coming to God

Hebrews 7:25 Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.

## Loving the Truth

2 Thessalonians 2:10 and in every sort of evil that deceives those who are perishing. They

perish because they refused to love the truth and so be saved.

## Belief

Mark 16:16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Acts 16:31 They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household."

Romans 10:10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.

2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we ought always to thank God for you, brothers loved by the Lord, because from the beginning God chose you to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth.

## By Faith

Luke 7:50 Jesus said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you; go in peace."

## Through Grace

Ephesians 2:4-5 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.

Ephesians 2:8-9 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.

Acts 15:11 We believe it is through the grace of our Lord Jesus that we are saved, just as they are."

## Confession

Romans 10:9-10 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.

## Believers Baptism & Renewal of the Holy Spirit

Mark 16:16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Titus 3:4-7 But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that,

having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we ought always to thank God for you, brothers loved by the Lord, because from the beginning God chose you to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth.

1 Peter 3:18-21 For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit, through whom also he went and preached to the spirits in prison who disobeyed long ago when God waited patiently in the days of Noah while the ark was being built. In it only a few people, eight in all, were saved through water, and this water symbolizes baptism that now saves you also—not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a good conscience toward God. It saves you by the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

## Works

James 2:14 What good is it, my brothers, if a man claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save him? (A rhetorical question - works are part of the saving process)

## Standing Firm

Matthew 10:22 All men will hate you because of me, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.

Matthew 24:9-13 <sup>9</sup>“Then you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of me. <sup>10</sup> At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other, <sup>11</sup> and many false prophets will appear and deceive many people. <sup>12</sup> Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, <sup>13</sup> but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.

Mark 13:13 All men will hate you because of me, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.

1 Corinthians 15:2 By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you.

1 Timothy 2:15 But women will be saved through childbearing— if they continue in faith, love and holiness with propriety.

1 Timothy 4:15-16 <sup>15</sup> Be diligent in these matters; give yourself wholly to them, so that everyone may see your progress. <sup>16</sup> Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both yourself and your hearers.

Hebrews 10:35-39 <sup>35</sup> So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. <sup>36</sup> You

need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised. <sup>37</sup> For in just a very little while, “He who is coming will come and will not delay. <sup>38</sup> But my righteous one will live by faith. And if he shrinks back, I will not be pleased with him.”

<sup>39</sup> But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who believe and are saved.

### Sinner Forgiven of Error

James 5:19-20 <sup>19</sup> My brothers, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring him back, <sup>20</sup> remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of his way will save him from death and cover over a multitude of sins.

### How Are We Saved? - Through A Process of Salvation

1 Corinthians 1:18 For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

2 Corinthians 2:15 For we are to God the aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing.

God pursues us, not once, but all throughout our journey as we are ‘being saved’
