More Than Enough The Responsibility of Being Blessed



Key Scriptures

And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others ... Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous. And when we take your gifts to those who need them, they will thank God. 2 Corinthians 9:8, 11 NLT

Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

Talk about something good that happened to you this week.

Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Which part of this message was most impactful for you and why?
- Read Luke 12:18-21. How can someone be rich toward God with their time, talents, and resources?
- How can we balance generosity with saving money?

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Share about a time when God blessed one area of your life. What happened? How did this blessing affect you?
- How can the blessings you experience lead you to bless others? In other words, how can you use your time, talents, and resources to make a difference?
- Do financial challenges make generosity feel impossible right now? If so, share how the group can pray for you.

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Dear God, thank You for blessing us. We ask that You would help us to be a blessing to the people around us. Put people in our path this week who need to experience Your love and provide us with the courage to be generous. In Jesus' name, amen.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
