Background

- Our beliefs are summed up in the **Apostles' Creed**
- Many atheists believe in **Scientific Materialism** which denies anything **Supernatural**
- Christians believe in the Supernatural, as God is a **Spirit** (John 4:24)

God's Nature

- God is a **Person** and part of the **Trinity**.
- The first aspect of God is that God is **Relational**
- A second aspect of God is that God is **Holy**, He will not allow **Sin** to be in His presence
- God gives us **Freedom** to accept or reject Him
- A third aspect is that God usually respects the **Consequences** of Science and Nature

Our Condition

- We are created in God's **Image**, to be relational and to love God
- Working against us are the Flesh, the Devil and the World System
- One of the Devil's biggest schemes is to pretend that he doesn't
 Exist

God's Solution

- Reasoning:
 - God hates Sin
 - Some things need to be **Punished**
 - God needed a Sacrifice
- Five Requirements that the Sacrifice must do:
 - 1. **Remove** our sins.
 - 2. Pay the **Penalty** for our sins
 - 3. Clean creation from the stench of **Sin**

God's Solution (cont.)

- Five Requirements that the Sacrifice must do (cont.):
 - 4. Victory over **Death** and the **Grave**
 - 5. Deal with **Evil** and **Satan**
- The Solution the Ultimate Sacrifice

Jesus became human, lived a sinless life, was crucified and raised from the dead

- What we need to do:
 - Believe that **Christ** died for us.
 - Admit that we are sinners, **Confess** and repent.
 - Turn our **Lives** over to Christ
 - Grow in Christ
 - Read the Bible
 - Pray daily
 - Continue **Meeting** with other believers

My Best Answer to the Question

- Sin has corrupted us and all Creation,
- This means that bad things can happen
