**OUTLINE**

**I.** If a person believes in Jesus Christ as the Saviour, God the Father recognizes that person as accepted into the Kingdom of God – that person is now one of God's forever. (*Romans 14:3*)

**II.** The job of Judge is taken, and it is not for anyone else but Jesus Christ. (*Romans 14:4; John 5:22-23*)

**III.** Once we receive Jesus Christ as our Saviour, we have sworn an allegiance to the King of Kings. We are now returned home to GOD. (*Romans 14:7,8*)
