I. Jesus is speaking with knowledge of things He would not have known other than through God's will and His Spirit – because they, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, are one. (*John 7:16, 3:11; Matthew 11:27; Deuteronomy 18:15,18,19*)

II. When a person believes in Jesus and publicly confesses that belief they now have three things, 1) **FORGIVENESS**: (*Romans 4:5-8; Matthew 26:28*) of everything they have done or will do against God, 2) **REDEMPTION**: (*Romans 3:21-26*) the rescuing from our enslavement to sin and eternal condemnation to an eternally reconciled relationship with God, (*John 17:3*), and 3) they are a **NEW CREATION** with Christ in You, (*2 Corinthians 5:17*).
