- V. Rejoice in every day because each day is a gift from God even the tough days. (Ps 118:22-24; 31:7; Phil 4:3; Rom. 12:12; Isa: 61:10)
- VI. We are blessed because we have chosen God over the world. (Ps 118: 25-29; James 1:17; 2 Cor. 9:8)

Every day we experience the beauty of God's creation is a blessing. Some days are better than others, and some days can be quite difficult. During those challenging times, remember this: "The LORD is the one who goes ahead of you; He will be with you. He will not fail you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed" (Deut 31:8).
