OUTLINE

- **I.** Mature Christians are not content with merely existing as a church. Instead, they desire to see the church become an essential part of their community. (*Romans* 12:9–21)
- II. The mature Christian understands that he or she is to serve the master Jesus Christ. Servanthood is a position of action, not relaxation. (Colossians 3:23–25)
- III. The mature believer should be recognized as a devoted servant who exemplifies a strong work ethic, harmony, love, compassion, righteousness, and peace within their community. They are blessed and should be a blessing to others, regardless of the circumstances. (Romans 12:9–21)
