I. Jesus cared so much for these men who served with Him that He told the truth about their future, even though their future was not a very pleasant one. (*John 16:1-4; 8:19, 55; 15:18–27; 17:25; Acts 3:17; 1 John 3:1*)

II. The Holy Spirit is the disciples and our direct connection to the Trinity, and within the Trinity comes everything we need to serve and honor God in our physical, mental, and spiritual life. (*John 7:33; 14:7; 16:10, 17, 28*)

III. Even in our darkest days, we can be assured that Jesus is coming back to make things right for all those who believe in Him. (*Jn 16:19–20, 20:20; Lk 23:27; Mk 16:10*)

IV. Christians can have peace in tribulation that the world can never understand, because our peace is since Jesus has already overcome the world. (*Jn 16:33; Rom 8:37; 2 Cor 2:14; 4:7ff; 6:4ff; Rev 3:21; 12:11*)
