Because of a riot, Emperor Claudius <u>deported the Jews</u> .

The big question: Who are the <u>people</u> of <u>God</u> ?
1. <u>Jewish</u> perspective.
Jesus, the disciples, all early converts were <u>Jewish</u> .
_ <mark>James</mark> versus _ <mark>Paul</mark>
2. <u>Gentile</u> perspective.
Since the Jews <u>rejected</u> Jesus, <u>God</u> has <u>rejected</u> them.
Paul uses the metaphor of the <u>potter</u> and <u>clay</u> .

<ul> <li>If you are correct in your <u>theology</u> and wrong on <u>unity</u>, you are <u>wrong</u>.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Do the hard work to become <u>ONE</u> <u>Church</u>.</li> </ul>
