The Holy Spirit in the Old Testament

The Hebrew word for spirit is <u>ruach</u>. It is also the word for <u>breath</u> and wind

The Greek word for spirit is <u>pneuma</u>.

Holy Spirit in the Old Testament speaks primarily of <u>power</u>. Some have said it means <u>air in motion</u>.

Ruach is a <u>dynamic</u> force.

The Person of the Holy Spirit in the New Testament

- 1 John 2:1

Advocate = parakletos, the one who comes along side to help.

In 1 John 2:1, the PARAKLETOS is <u>Jesus</u>.

In John 14:16, the PARAKLETOS is <u>the Holy Spirit</u>.

Therefore, the Holy Spirit is a <u>**PERSON**</u>, not just a force.
