In Matthew 27, Pilate washes his hands in a basin and says, "Not my responsibility." In John 13, Jesus uses a basin to wash his disciples' feet. At any given time we can live by 1 of 2 'basin theologies.' We can take our basin and wash our hands of the world or we can take our basin and wash the feet of the world.

4. Which 'basin theology' do you think people are more prone to live by? Which are you more prone to use? Explain.
