- 1. Jesus comes to display in all he says and does the once hidden <u>character of our God</u>.
- 2. Jesus is One with God. Jesus is God!
- 3. John the Baptist was to <u>prepare</u> the way for Jesus.
- 4. John the Baptist preached about <u>repentance</u>.
- 5. <u>People</u> unwilling to change could not come to Jesus.
- 6. John the Baptist, also offered water baptism as a sign of repentance.
- 7. John declared the greatness of Jesus.
- 8. John wasn't worthy to be Jesus' humblest slave!
- 9. John said he was so unworthy to even untie <u>Jesus' shoes</u>, a job that slaves usually did.
- 10. We too can speak of Jesus who is about to appear again.

- 17. Leaders who are change agents always <u>transform</u> the traditional paradigm.
- 18. Healthy leaders are first <u>servants</u>.
- 19. Effective leaders balance the need for solitude and socializing.

- 20. Good leaders provide security and confidence for their followers.
- 21. The greater the leader, the greater the humility and <u>sacrifice</u> required.
- 22. Principles serve effective <u>leaders</u> so leaders can effectively serve the people.
- 23. Good Leaders prepare the way for <u>Change</u>.
- 24. One of the marks of an excellent leader is how he or she brings about <u>transformation</u> in people and organizations.
