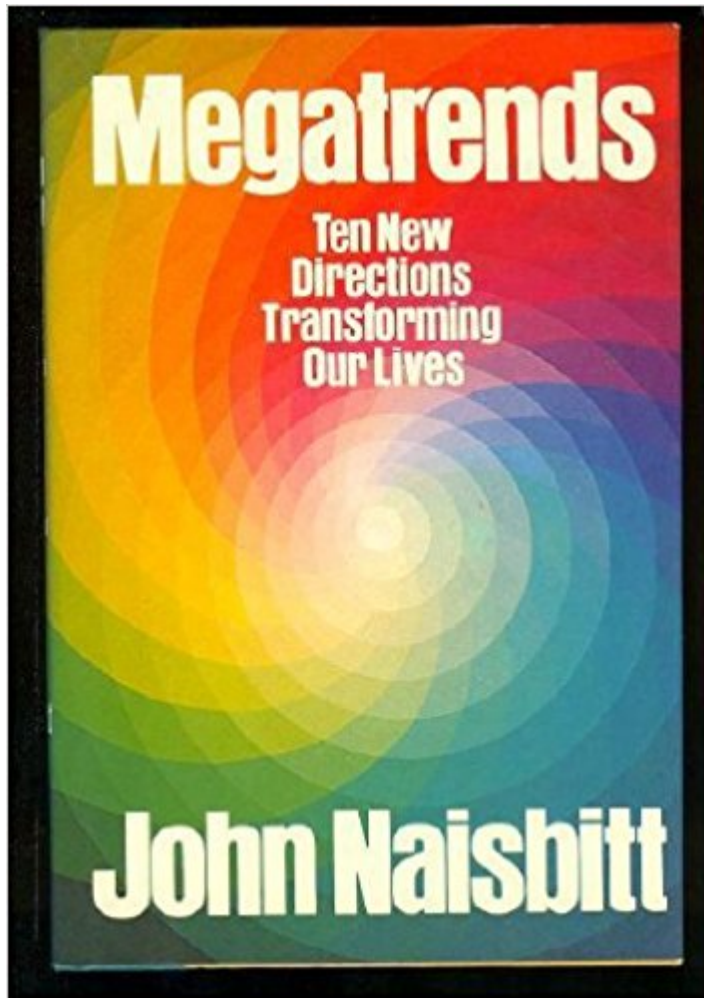

Trend 1 – The Daily Me.

Trend 2 – Neo- Medieval

In the early middle ages, they mixed paganism with Christianity - syncretism.

In the Renaissance, man became the measure of all things.

Following history – 5 Dynamics:

- Spiritual illiteracy.
- Spiritual openness to anything.

Trend 3 – The Culture of Offense.

Microaggressions are small actions or word choices that seem, on their face, to have no malicious intent, but that are thought of as a kind of violence nonetheless.

Trigger warnings are alerts that professors are expected to issue if something in a course might cause a strong emotional response.

Vindictive protectiveness is creating a culture in which everyone must think twice before speaking up, lest they face charges of insensitivity, aggression, or worse.

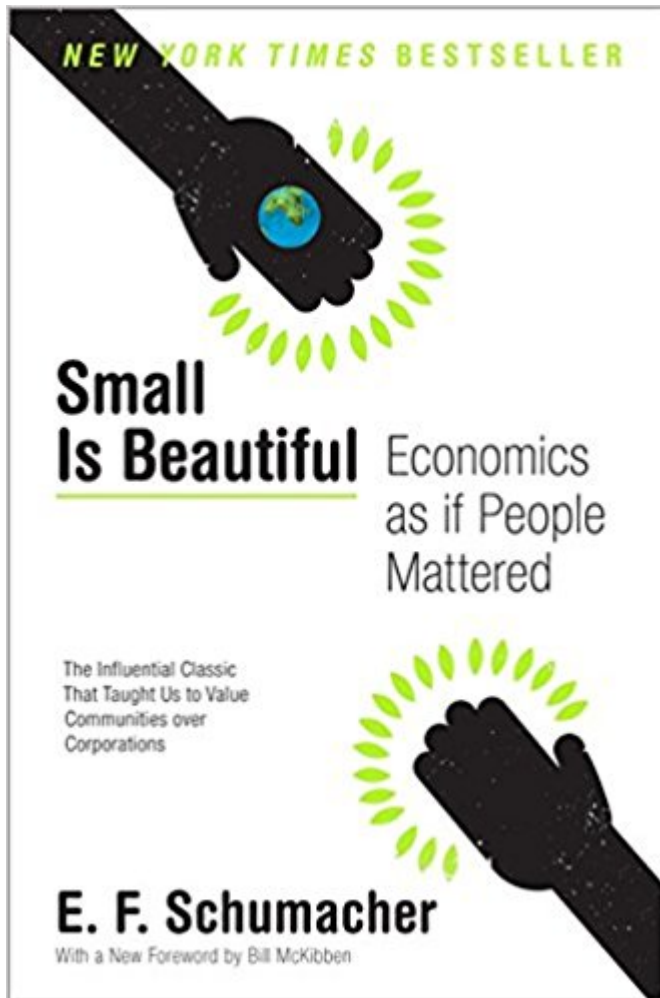
